

## **Camp Huston Scholarships**

Camp Huston scholarships are available from the Office of the Bishop for campers who would not be able to have a camping experience without financial assistance. The Bishop Curtis scholarship pays one-third of the cost with the congregation and family each paying one-third as well.

### **Scholarship application process:**

- The camper sends his/her registration and deposit to Camp Huston with a note on the registration form indicating that the camper will be requesting scholarship assistance.
  
- The camper's clergy (or senior warden if the congregation is in search) sends a letter or email to Bishop Rickel, via Tiffany Brannon at [TBrannon@ecww.org](mailto:TBrannon@ecww.org), requesting scholarship assistance. The letter must include:
  - the camper's name
  - the session the camper is registered for
  
- The clergy will receive a letter from the Bishop's office confirming the amount of the scholarship. The clergy will then pass that information along to the camper's family.
  
- The Bishop's Office notifies Camp Huston of the scholarship that has been awarded. The amount of the scholarship is credited to the camper's account at Camp Huston.
